

Decision Item: CaFCP Medium- and Heavy-Duty FCEV Action Plan

BACKGROUND:

In early 2015 a taskforce was formed in response to the medium- and heavy-duty activities outlined in the adopted 2015 CaFCP Program Plan. Throughout 2015 the taskforce identified needs and challenges, conducted multiple stakeholder workshops and developed early drafts of a MD/HD Action Plan. By early 2016 a final draft document was developed and gained the support of the taskforce, Working Group and Steering Team. This MD/HD FCEV Action Plan outlines actions toward assessing the precursors for sustainable commercialization by;

- Identifying two vocational categories/platforms (Class 4-6 urban delivery trucks, Class 7-8 short haul/drayage trucks),
- Outlining the elements of a sustainable business case,
- Identifying priority rollout regions in California,
- Identifying capacity, distribution and siting needs for infrastructure, and
- Recommending specific actions and activities to support technology validation.

Once approved for publication, the taskforce and CaFCP will support implementation of the action plan to advance California progress in these applications, and seek to translate these activities into additional statewide or national rollout opportunities.
