

Update: Hydrogen Distribution and Supply in California As of 20 March 2020

The California Fuel Cell Partnership (CaFCP) is providing an update on the hydrogen infrastructure and supply chain for the California retail fueling network.

Retail hydrogen stations are currently open and being supplied with hydrogen, while considering California COVID-19 guidance.

The California Energy Commission clarified all elements of the fuel supply chain, including hydrogen fueling stations, are essential services to remain open during the COVID-19 response <https://www.energy.ca.gov/news/2020-03/state-clarifies-fuel-providers-are-open-business-essential-services-during-covid>.
